

Heartsaver AED Training

Heartsaver AED is a 4.5 hour American Heart Association (AHA) accredited training class offered by Environmental Health & Safety which covers adult/child CPR and foreign body airway obstruction and the automatic external defibrillator (AED). Individuals who successfully complete the course will receive AHA training cards for Basic Life Support (BLS) CPR.

The AHA requires biennial CPR recertification and annual AED skills recertification. Because EHS recommends that previously qualified individuals take the full course annually to maintain CPR & AED skills, a Heartsaver **AED** “refresher” course is not offered and AHA training cards will only be offered biennially.

The class is typically offered on the third Thursday of every month (except Holidays) in 7400 York Road, room 302A from 8am-12:30pm. Additional classes may be scheduled as needed. Space is limited to a minimum of 4 with a maximum of 10 individuals per class and advance registration is required. The class is only open to University faculty, staff and employees and there is no charge. Contact EHS to verify exact class dates & times.
