









Deleting Queries

1.	<p>Begin by navigating to the Query Manager page. Click the Reporting Tools link.</p> 
2.	<p>Click the Query Manager button.</p> 
3.	<p>Enter the desired information into the Search By field. Enter a valid value e.g. "CUSTOM00_GENDER_RATIO_ANALYSIS".</p>
4.	<p>Click the Search button.</p> 
5.	<p>Select the CUSTOM00_GENDER_RATIO_ANALYSIS query. Click the CUSTOM00_GENDER_RATIO_ANALYSIS option.</p> 
6.	<p>Click the *Action list.</p> 
7.	<p>You can select an option to perform the required operation, such as copy, delete, move, or rename, on the selected query. In this example, you need to delete the selected query. Click an entry in the list.</p> 
8.	<p>Click the Go button.</p> 
9.	<p>The Delete Confirmation page enables you to confirm that you want to delete the query you have identified. Click the Yes button.</p> 
10.	<p>Notice that the CUSTOM00_GENDER_RATIO_ANALYSIS query has been deleted.</p>
11.	<p>You successfully deleted the CUSTOM00_GENDER_RATIO_ANALYSIS query. End of Procedure.</p>
