- McAfee / ePO upgrade coming:** Office of Technology Services (OTS) staff will need to visit all university Macs that were purchased prior to April 2009, to upgrade McAfee antivirus software to version 8.6. Details on the plan to perform the McAfee updates will be announced soon.
