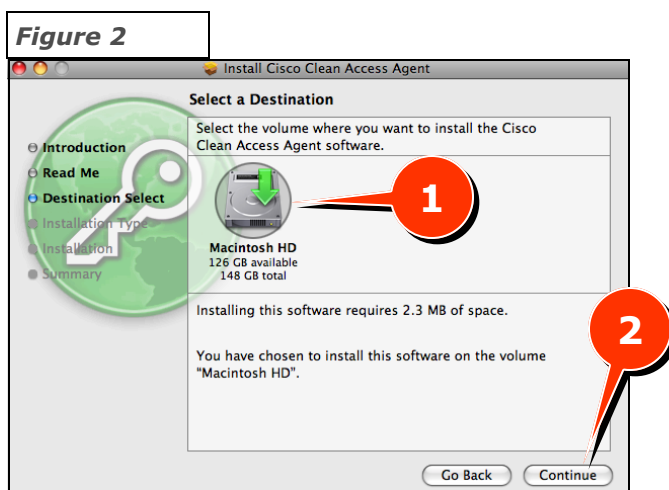
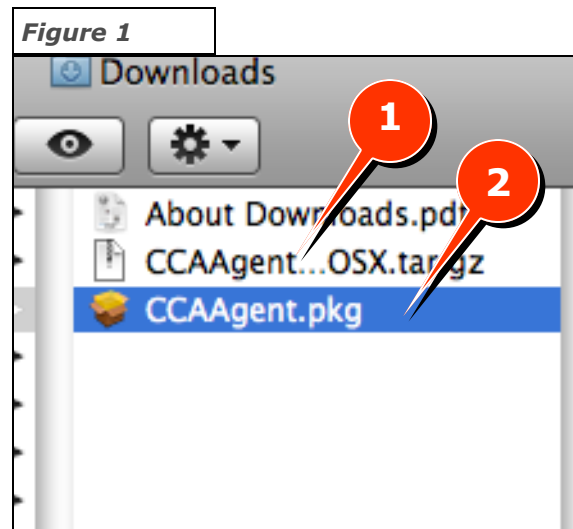
### Introduction

The **tu-secure** wireless network allows a secure wireless connection for faculty, staff, and students. **Students** will need to download the Clean Access Agent below to connect to tu-secure.

### Access the Internet

After you have set up the tu-secure on your laptop you will need to complete the following steps

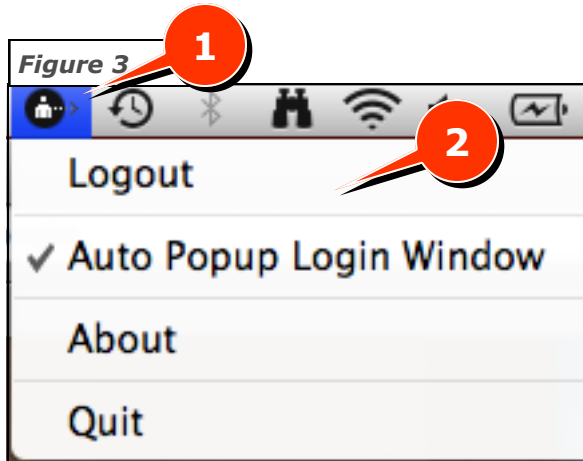
1. Open your **Web Browser**
2. Enter **NetID (username & password)**
3. Click **Continue**
4. Click **Download Clean Access Agent**
5. Go to **Downloads**
6. Click on **CCAAgent...OSX.tar.gz** (Fig 1, 1)
7. Click on **CCAAgent.pkg** (Fig 1, 2)
8. Click **Continue** for the guide
9. Click **Continue** for the ReadMe content
10. Select the **Destination** (Fig 2, 1) and click **Continue** (Fig 2, 2)
11. Click **Install**
12. Type in your **NetID (username & password)** and click **OK**
13. Click **Close**
14. Login to the **Cisco Clean Access Agent**
15. Click **Ok** to the success screen



## Log out of Clean Access

When you are finished using your wireless connection you will want to log out.

1. **Clean Access icon** in the top right corner (Fig 3, 1)
2. Select **Logout** (Fig 3, 2)



## Clean Access Maintenance

Every time you access the tu-secure network Clean Access will scan your machine for updates. These updates will need to be completed before you can gain full access to the internet. You will be given about two hours to access [www.towson.edu/cleanaccess](http://www.towson.edu/cleanaccess) and a few other sites to remediate the problems.
