Excellence in Education Awards

This award recognizes excellence in teacher education. Recipients have substantially contributed to the mission and goals of Towson University and the College of Education through their inspirational leadership; outstanding model of teaching excellence; and/or significant community work on behalf of education.



Faculty Excellence Award

Awarded to regular COE faculty and lecturers who have substantially contributed to the mission and goals of Towson University and the College of Education through inspirational leadership and provision of an outstanding model of teaching excellence, advising, and scholarship.

Frances T. Bond Service Award

Award for students who have substantially contributed to the mission and goals of Towson University and the College of Education through significant community service on behalf of education.

Teacher Education Excellence Award

Award for students who have substantially contributed to the mission and goals of Towson University and the College of Education through their outstanding model of teaching excellence.

Alumni Excellence Award

Award for alumni who have substantially contributed to the mission and goals of Towson University and the College of Education through inspirational leadership; outstanding model of teaching excellence; and/or significant community work on behalf of education.

Staff Excellence Award

Award for staff member who has substantially contributed to the mission and goals of Towson University and made specific contributions to the College of Education.

Eligibility

Eligibility is available to a range of College of Education persons whose work has substantially supported the mission and goals of Towson University and the College of Education and has specifically enhanced the excellence of teacher education.

- COE Professionals: Regular faculty, lecturers, administrators, and staff
