- SCED 201 **Foundations of Education** (3) Prerequisite None
- SCED 305 **Adolescent Learning, Development, and Diversity** (3) Prerequisite PSYC 101 or 102
- ISTC 301 **Integrating Instructional Technology** (3) Prerequisite ISTC 201
- SPED 301 **Introduction to Special Education K-12** (3) Prerequisite PSYC 201

### CORE COURSES Students must meet with their SCED advisor & provide acceptable Praxis I, SAT, ACT or GRE scores .

- SCED 341 **Principles of Secondary Education** (4) – field experience included, transportation/travel time required, time – also offered during summer semester.
- SCED 460 **Using Reading and Writing in the Secondary School** (4) – taken concurrently with SCED 341

Can be taken throughout program excluding final semester.

- SCED 419 **Young Adult Literature** (3) ENGLISH Majors Only
- SOSC 401 **Topics in Social Science** (3) SOSC, HIST, and GEOG Majors Only

- SCED 499 **Internship in Secondary Education** (6)  
Taken at Professional Development School (PDS) Center immediately prior to Student Teaching and concurrent with Methods of Teaching Major Subject and SCED 461

- SCED 461 **Teaching Reading in the Secondary Content Area** (3)  
concurrently with Student Teaching
