Minutes

- 1) Professor Cockey moved and Ms. Miller seconded approval of the agenda. Motion carried 8 – 0 – 0.
- 2) Minutes of March 14, 2011: Professor O'Pecko moved and Professor Robertson seconded the motion that the Minutes be approved. Motion carried 8 – 0 – 0.
- 3) Proposed Changes in the Department of Art + Design, Art History and Art Education to the Program in Graphic Design Concentration - AND
- 4) Proposed Changes in the Department of Art + Design, Art History and Art Education to the Program in Digital Art and Design Concentration –Dr. Stuart Stein: Numbers 3 and 4 were discussed together. The changes requested would give more choice in courses in their areas of focus in the BFA programs. Professor Faulkner moved and Professor Cockey seconded the motion that the changes in both be approved. The motion carried 8 – 0 – 0.
- 5) Proposed Changes to the Major in the Department of Mathematics – Dr. Raouf Boules: At the recommendation of an external review agency and to align better with our peer institutions, the department would like to add 3 – 4 credits to the Applied Math and Pure Math concentrations. Mr. Giordani moved and Ms. Sweeney seconded approval of the changes to the Pure Math concentration. Motion carried 8 – 0 – 0. Mr. Giordani moved and Professor O'Pecko seconded the motion that the changes to the Applied Math concentration be approved subject to Committee's receipt of the final copy of the proposal. Motion carried 8 – 0 – 0.
- 6) Proposed Changes in the Department of Health Science to the School Health Teacher Education Concentration - Dr. Donna Cox: The department proposes to drop PSYC 201 but add SCED 305. This has the concurrence of the Psychology and the Secondary Education departments. Mr. Giordani moved and Professor Robertson seconded the motion to approve this change. The motion carried 8 – 0 – 0.

- 7) Proposed Changes in the Department of Theatre Arts to the Theatre Studies Track – Dr. Jay Herzog: A new Community Engagement course, THEA 403, is proposed for the Theatre Studies track. Students are doing it now under internships, but this makes it formal. Professor Faulkner moved and Ms. Fowler seconded the motion to approve these changes. The motion carried 8 – 0 – 0.
- 8) Proposed Program Change from the Department of Political Science – Dr. Toni Marzotto: The department proposed adding 7 courses into the topical areas. The courses were approved in 2010. Professor O’Pecko moved and Professor Faulkner seconded the motion to approve these changes. The motion carried 8 – 0 – 0.
