Abilities Network - Community Employment Associate: I work with individuals in the community to help them function like everyone else. I help them find and maintain employment, find and use transportation, budget money, grocery shop, maintain the home, and get to the doctor. I also maintain all the paperwork and I am a team manager.
Adoptions Together – Assessment Services Program Assistant: I assist families with adoption/home study application intakes. I am the coordinator for clearances, and I act as the liaison for families who may have questions. I also assist with the Child and Family Services contract under Adoptions Together.
Aerotek – Business System Analyst I am the Database Administrator (weekly reporting in access), the PeopleSoft Administrator, the Performance Learning Management System Administrator (PLMS), and the Leadership and Management Coordinator. I manage 145 Recruiter Leads, and I conduct diversity training.
Alliance Inc. – Forensic Program Manager: I am the program manager for court diversion programs, I work with inmates in Harford County Detention Center for re-entry and diversion, and I work with clients in community settings. All clients are diagnosed with serious mental illnesses. Additionally, I supervise staff and help with program development.
Anne Arundel County Public Schools - Special Education Teacher I am a special educator working in a general education classroom as a co-teacher. I teach seventh grade language arts and social studies.
Arizona State Hospital - Neuro-Adolescent Clinician: I work with children, adults, and families with severe mental health problems as well as pervasive developmental disorders. I work as the patient's counselor and I work with their families.
Arrow Child and Family Ministries - Associate Clinical Director-Foster Care Department: My position is a middle level management position. I directly oversee and supervise a team of four foster care case managers. I provide them with clinical supervision, crisis management, and training. I am also in charge of Foster Care Intake and Admissions.
Baltimore County DSS - Case Monitor/Family Violence Unit: The Case Monitors at Baltimore County DSS staff the Domestic Violence Referral Program (DVRP). The Baltimore County DVRP is an alternative sentencing program designed to monitor offenders who are court-ordered to attend and complete a 26 session Abuser Intervention Program. The DVRP monitors clients who are referred by a judge in Baltimore County, or who are residents of Baltimore County. Currently, the DVRP is monitoring the Healthy Relationship program, which is a four session domestic violence information and education focused program. This program has been designed for first time domestic violence offenders and only those referred by the District Court of Baltimore County.
Baltimore City Child Care Resource Center - Family Services Coordinator: I am a case manager and a family services coordinator for Head Start families throughout Baltimore City.
Baltimore County Police Department - Counseling Intern: I am currently an intern at the BCPD in the counseling department. I counsel juveniles and families who are in crisis. I will be at a new internship site in one month.

<p>Baltimore Crisis Response - Hotline Counselor: As a hotline counselor I provide supportive counseling, send mobile crisis team interventions, contact 911, conduct intake, and provide general information about the agency for clients or callers in crisis. I work with suicide, homicide, family distress, substance abuse, medication and treatment non-compliance, and I provide advice on stress-related issues.</p>
<p>Carole Robertson Center for Learning - Preschool Teacher: I am a preschool teacher for children ages zero to five.</p>
<p>Center of Applied Technology – North - School Counselor: I conduct small group, individual, and classroom guidance lessons in the areas of academic, career, and personal social development.</p>
<p>Children's Hospital of Philadelphia - Child Life Specialist: I am the Child Life Specialist in the Day Surgical Unit.</p>
<p>Children's National Medical Center - Child Life Specialist: I am the Child Life Specialist on the Medical Care Unit for children ages 0-10.</p>
<p>Cigna - Provider Relations Representative: For the states of Georgia, Indiana, Michigan, & Ohio, I manage all the behavioral health practitioners, clinics, and facilities that hold a contract with Cigna Behavioral Health (CBH) to provide services to those who have CBH insurance. My responsibilities include but are not limited to addressing and resolving all complaints, negotiating contract stipulations, and facilitating positive interactions between the contract holders and the clinical staff within CBH.</p>

<p>DC Prep Academy - Spanish Teacher: I teach Spanish to preschool and kindergarten students at a charter school in DC.</p>
<p>Department of Juvenile Services – Case Management Specialist III: I am a juvenile probation officer in the Department of Juvenile Services. I plan for youth's re-entry into the community, provide reports for court, refer youths to appropriate resources, and supervise youths on probation.</p>
<p>Enchanted Beginnings Daycare - Owner and Provider: I am the owner and provider of this home daycare service.</p>
<p>Harford County Public School - Family and Consumer Science Teacher: I am a Family and Consumer Science teacher at Bel Air High School where I teach 10th-12th grade students. The courses I teach are Learning about Children, and Independent and Family Living.</p>
<p>Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center - Community Relations Coordinator: I visit local elementary schools and teach 3rd and 4th graders about heart health. I also work with girl scouts, take blood pressures at local community centers and participate in health fairs.</p>
<p>Kennedy Krieger Institute - Assistant Teacher: I am working with one of Kennedy Krieger's school programs. The school is located in Rockville MD and is primarily for students with autism. My classroom is composed of seven students with challenging behavioral issues who are all on the lower end of the autism spectrum. I am one of two assistant teachers in the room, and I teach lessons throughout the week in collaboration with the other teachers and aides in my classroom. I love it!</p>
<p>La Petite Academy – Director: I supervise a building filled with 111 children and 30 teachers. I enroll new families, train staff on topics related to ECED, and organize workshops.</p>

<p>Lorien Health System - Activity Assistant: I provide support to the activity director by planning and implementing meaningful activities at a long term care facility.</p>
<p>Mercy High School and Cabot Creamery - Alumnae and Development Coordinator & Event Coordinator: At Mercy High School I am currently assisting in the Annual Fund and planning alumnae events. For Cabot, I am a promoter of Cabot Creamery at local events. Cabot is a cooperative and does not have much money for commercial marketing so it is my job to educate consumers about buying and supporting sustainable agriculture.</p>
<p>Montgomery County Public Schools - Spec. Para-educator: I assist special needs students in an all inclusive program.</p>
<p>Prince George's County Public Schools - Kindergarten Teacher: I am a kindergarten teacher from August through June.</p>
<p>Prologue, Inc – Case Manager: I am a case manager for a homeless outreach program. I refer services to homeless people in Baltimore County to help them reach a point of self-sufficiency.</p>
<p>Sheppard Pratt Health System - Clinical Research Coordinator: We test new medications that are not yet on the market for individuals with depression, bipolar disorder, schizophrenia, etc. All of our studies are outpatient studies.</p>
<p>Social Security Administration - Service Representative I work directly with the public by answering questions concerning Social Security, SSI, and Medicare benefits. I also manage a caseload of Social Security beneficiaries.</p>
<p>The Center for Prevention of Abuse – Court Advocate: I aid clients who petition for orders of protection, I support clients appearing pro-se during emergency and plenary hearings, and I coordinate courtroom hearings with clerks, bailiffs, and clients. I also rotate staff coverage in two county facilities, educate clients regarding domestic violence issues, and provide appropriate referrals for clients.</p>
