Important Information you Need to Know Regarding the Praxis I Exam:

Praxis I exam should be taken before or while you are enrolled in HLTH 222. For additional information please check our website at: <http://www.towson.edu/healthscience/healthed/schoolhealthed.asp>

ETS (Educational Testing Service) has informed us of the following:

“Starting with the November 2008 ETS administration, examinees who register for Praxis I tests online will only be able to access their score reports online; they will **not** receive paper score reports in the mail. (*Please Note:* When candidates are emailed their ETS score report, they need to print out a hard copy **immediately** for the reports will only be available online for 45 days thereafter.) Those examinees who register by mail or by phone will only receive paper score reports. ”

“The electronic score reports are issued in a locked PDF, which prevents examinees from being able to alter the report; however, if you chose to accept a printed copy of the electronic report, please use the same caution you would in accepting a paper score report. As always, please contact us if you suspect that a score report has been altered.”

Students are urged to keep a copy of the score report for their own records, but they also must provide a copy to the Center for Professional Practice (Hawkins Hall) and bring a copy to the Health Science Department Office, Burdick 141 for their student file. These scores must be in your department academic files at the beginning of the semester **prior** to when you begin your student teaching.
