Requirements for Good Academic Standing and continuation in the Honors College.

1. Cumulative 3.3 GPA in all Towson University courses.
2. Cumulative 3.0 GPA in Honors courses.
3. Successfully complete 6 Honors units by the end of the first year of study, 12 Honors units by the end of the second year, and 18 Honors units by the end of the third year.

Students who fall below the requirements for good standing will be placed on Honors Probation for at least one semester, and they will become academically ineligible to participate in the Honors College if they fail to return to good standing by the end of the probationary period.

The pass grading option is not available for Honors courses taken to fulfill requirements for the Honors College. (Students are allowed to switch an Honors course to the pass grading option, but it will no longer count towards their Honors requirements.)
