

## **Calendar Year 2004 Bachelor's Degree Recipients One-Year Follow-Up Alumni Survey**

In the spring and summer of 2005, the Office of Institutional Research conducted a one-year follow up survey of the 2,740 alumni who received a Bachelor's degree in calendar year 2004. After taking into account surveys that were undeliverable, the mailing resulted in a response rate of 24.5% and a final sample of 647 respondents. Attached is a set of tables presenting the responses for each item of the survey.

### Survey Highlights:

#### **Characteristics:**

- 72% of respondents were female compared to 63% of all degree recipients (Table 1A).
- The distribution of respondents by race/ethnicity was similar to the distribution among degree recipients for the race/ethnicity of African American (8.4% graduated, 8% of respondents were African American), Native American (.4% graduated, .3% of respondents were Native American), Asian (2.7% graduated, 2.9% of respondents were Asian), and Hispanic (1.7% graduated, 1.1% of respondents were Hispanic) (Table 1B).
- The distribution of respondents by race/ethnicity that were represented somewhat disproportionately were White (78.8% graduated, 84.5% responded), Foreign (2.9% graduated, .6% responded) and Unknown (5.1% graduated, 2.5% responded) (Table 1B).

## **Calendar Year 2004 Bachelor's Degree Recipients One-Year Follow-Up Alumni Survey**

### **Major and Degree:**

- The distribution for respondents by college is close to all degree recipients by college, with the exception of Liberal Arts (26.5% graduated, 24.9% respondents), Education (11.7% graduated, 13.8% respondents), and Fine Arts/Communication (20.6% graduated, 18.9% responded) (Table 2).

### **Residence & Employment:**

- 26% of Maryland residents at time of enrollment were male, while 74% of them were female. 37% of out of state residents were male, while 63% of out of state residents were female (Table 3).
- 84% of students at enrollment were residents of Maryland, and 16% were out of state. These graduates now are represented by 81% being Maryland residents and 19% out of state residents (Table 4).
- 75.4% of respondents agreed that Towson University had at least a level of "good preparation" for Graduate School, 12.6% of students didn't enroll in grad school (Table 7).
- 92.8% of graduates are currently employed, 66.7% of respondents being employed females, and 33.3% of respondents being employed males (Table 8A).
- 72.8% of graduates are employed in Maryland, while 8.3% are employed in DC or a neighboring state (Table 9).
- 23.7% of graduates are Teachers, 11.8% of graduates are in the Financial Industry, 11.8% of graduates are in Sales &/or Marketing, and 10.5% are Health Professionals/Technicians (Table 10).

## **Calendar Year 2004 Bachelor's Degree Recipients One-Year Follow-Up Alumni Survey**

### **Residence & Employment Con't:**

- 68% of employed graduates claimed that a bachelor's degree is required for their occupation (Table 11).

### **Salary & Preparation:**

- 70.7% of full-time employed students have a current salary of at least \$30,000 per year (Table 12).
- 68% of full-time employed females have a current salary of at least \$30,000 per year, while 77% of full-time employed males have a current salary of at least \$30,000 per year (Table 13).
- 72% of respondents claimed that their major provided them with a level of at least "good" for job preparation. 5.2% of graduates were uncertain (Table 14).
- 79.3% of respondents claimed that their major was at least "somewhat related" to their current profession (Table 15A).
- 77.4% of respondents claimed that they would most likely attend Towson University again, if they had the choice. 75.2% of males said they'd most likely attend Towson again, while 77.8% of females said they'd most likely attend Towson again (Table 16A).
