New Undergraduate Trimester Program Starting in Summer 2009

The Department of Electronic Media and Film is offering a new trimester plan starting in Summer 2009. The trimester plan is open to transfer students, students who are changing majors and EMF majors. The new options are designed to offer students the opportunity to take the three basic core courses for the major. These core courses are also the screening courses that help to determine eligibility for full major status. In addition, EMF is offering courses that will allow students to get a head start on some of their other required courses.

Benefits of this Trimester program

- Availability of prerequisite lower level courses required for the major
- Students who are entering the major later in their academic careers will be able to take courses that will allow them to graduate within a reasonable timeframe
- Department trimester advisor available to meet with students beginning Spring 2009 and through summers and subsequent semesters.
- An opportunity for students taking a heavy course load to balance academic program and internships.
