Description

Need/Background:

- Starting Fall 2009, the SGA now receives fees from part time undergraduate students.
- Previously, the SGA did not recognize part-time undergraduate students as members of SGA affiliated student organizations
- The words, “full-time” must be removed from existing constitutions to account for the new fees from part-time undergraduate students. Part-time undergraduate students will now be recognized by the SGA.

Research:

- The SGA now receives \$3.00 per credit from part-time undergraduate students.
- Previously, when the SGA did not receive these fees, part-time students were recognized members of SGA affiliated student organizations. Because the SGA now receives these fees, part-time undergraduate students must be recognized

Action:

- The Student Government Association approves the removal of the words, “full-time”, from all existing SGA affiliated student organizations’ constitutions
