Description

Need/Background:

- The Towson University Student Government Association Constitution states in Article I, Section 2 (Student Senate Composition): “There will be four freshman senators and one transfer student senator appointed by the Executive Branch and approved by a two-thirds vote of the Student Senate every year in the month of September.”

Research:

- Freshmen and transfer senatorial applications were advertised throughout campus on the Daily Digest.
- Applications were made available on the Student Government Association website, at the Welcome Week Tent and in the Student Government Association Office (UU226).
- A Senator Selection Committee, headed by the Student Government Association Vice President and comprised of various Student Government Association Senators and Directors, interviewed candidates.
- After interviewing multiple candidates, recommendations were made by the Senator Selection Committee.
- The Student Government Association Vice President is nominating the following four freshman and one transfer student senatorial appointees.

- The Student Government Association approves the appointment of Timothy Flaherty, Caitlin Pomerantz and Emmanuel Welsh as Freshmen Senators and Megan Norris as a Transfer Senator for the 2009-2010 academic year.
