Description

Need/Background:

- The Art History Club (AHC) would like to travel to Philadelphia, PA on November 22, 2009 to visit the Gorky Retrospective at the Philadelphia Museum of Art.
- This trip was not funded in their Fall 2009 Budget and as they are a budgeted group, they are entitled to two supplementals per year, as indicated in the *Financial Policy*.
- This is AHC's first supplemental.
- Rule Five of the *Student Government Association By-Laws* states that all supplementals must be approved by the Student Government Legislative Branch.

Research:

- Transportation. FMA requests \$195.84 for transportation costs. (*See attached documents.*)
 - AHC would like to rent a 10-passenger van through University Fleet Services at \$0.96 per mile.
- Admission. AHC has budgeted enough money for the cost of admission for six students to attend and has stated that they will be willing to contribute money if more than six students attend.
