

Explore Baltimore

Article 1- Name

The name of this organization shall be “Explore Baltimore”

Article 2- Purpose

The purpose of the club shall be (a) to increase access to healthy alternative activities by exploring Baltimore, (b) to increase awareness of these alternatives, (c) facilitate participation in these events, (d) to shift Towson student’s perspectives about the activities they participate in.

Article 3- Membership

Section 1- Any fee paying, undergraduate student enrolled in Towson University with at least a 2.0 GPA may become a member of the Explore Baltimore club with voting rights and office holding privileges.

Article 4- Executive Officers

The executive officers of the Explore Baltimore club shall be as follows: President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer. The aforementioned officers shall constitute the Executive Committee.

Article 5- Duties of Executive Officers

President- To preside at executive committee and general meetings; appoint special committees with the approval of the Executive Board; to present an annual report; and perform other such duties as may be required by the By-Laws or resolutions of the Executive Committee.

Vice President- To preside in the President’s absence and perform other such duties as may be required by the By-Laws or resolutions of the Executive Committee; plan and organize publicity for activities and special events.

Secretary- To attend all general correspondence of the organization; to keep the minutes of all Executive Committee and general meetings; and to preserve the records of the organization. He or she will also perform other such duties as may be required by the By-Laws or resolutions of the Executive Committee.

Treasurer- Supervise the financial administration of all revenue periodically to the Executive Committee and membership on the financial condition of the organization, and perform other such duties as may be required by the By-Laws or resolutions of the Executive Committee.

Article 6- Committees of the Officers

If the need should arise, the Executive Committee may create committees that will report directly to the executive officer they are intended to assist. By-Laws will be created outlining the specific duties and responsibilities of any committee in question.

Article 7- Elections

1. Election of the officers shall take place yearly, on the second Monday of November. Incoming officers shall take affect immediately following the end of finals week.
2. Elections will be chaired by the outgoing president. He or she may also serve again if elected. If outgoing president in up for re-election, the advisor will chair the election
3. In the event of a tie a revote will be done.
4. Any student member is eligible to vote and for nomination as an officer of the Executive Committee who attend meetings regularly and meets the SGA qualifications.
5. An officer may be impeached by a 2/3 majority vote if he or she is not fulfilling their constitutional duties.

Article 8- Amendments

Amendments to this Constitution may be proposed by the voting membership for consideration by the Executive Committee following a petition signed by ¼ of voting eligible members. Amendments shall be declared or adopted upon SGA approval.

Article 9- By-Laws

By-Laws, not inconsistent with this constitution, may be adopted or amended by a 2/3 majority of the voting members present at any general or special meetings, provided the proposed By-Laws are submitted, to the President, at least one week prior to the meeting at which the proposals are to be considered. By-Laws may be created by a 3/4 majority among the Executive Committee. Amendments shall be declared or adopted upon SGA approval.

By-Law 1- By order of the Executive Committee, the Treasurer will have the power and authority to create a Financial Committee.

- (a) The Financial Committee, under direction of the Treasurer, shall act as agents for the organization.
 - a. The Financial Committee shall receive strategic direction upon decisions made by the Executive Committee.
 - b. The Financial Committee shall receive tactical direction from the Treasurer

By-Law 2- By order of the Executive Committee, the Vice-President will have the power and authority to create a Marketing Committee.

- (a) The Marketing Committee, under direction of the Vice-President, shall act as agents for the organization. Responsible for communicating to non-members the benefits of the organization.
