Thank you for showing interest in Towson University's Rho Alpha Chapter of Order of Omega. The purpose of Order of Omega is to recognize the top 3% of Greek students who have attained a high standard of leadership in inter-Greek activities, to encourage them to continue along this line, and to inspire others to strive for similar conspicuous attainment.

There are a few requirements that need to be met in order to apply. Applicants must be a full-time Towson University student who is affiliated with a Greek-lettered organization, a junior or senior in academic credit hours (60 credits or more), and possesses a cumulative GPA of 2.93 or higher. If selected into the Rho Alpha chapter of Order of Omega, there is a one-time fee for dues of \$60.

Applications are due on **Monday, October 19th by 5pm**. All applications **must be typed and in a folder with your name on** it and include a recommendation signed by a Towson University faculty member or Greek advisor. Please return completed applications to the Order of Omega mailbox in the Office of Student Activities, University Union 217.
