- Towson has 2 confirmed cases of H1N1 and about 45 reports of flu-like symptoms. We are prepared with rooms to quarantine those students who cannot return home to recover. Students, faculty and staff will all be encouraged to receive the seasonal flu vaccine on campus next week. Towson will also be a delivery site for the H1N1 vaccine when it is available.

**Off-Campus Shuttle Bus Routes (for Fall 2009)**

- Goucher Route will change roads to travel on Burke Avenue rather than Knollwood Road. A no parking area will be designated near the Donnybrook leasing office to allow for pick-up of students.
- Ridership is about 500 students per day.
- Campus shuttles do not operate during the summer, over breaks or when the university is closed for a holiday or inclement weather.

- TU is working with Towson Manor Village this fall on a Community Mediation Pilot Program. We hope to use this program to facilitate discussions between neighbors and students before conflict occurs and additionally to assist in resolving conflicts when appropriate. The facilitator would be from a county or non-profit organization in the county.
- The Community Ambassador program is being piloted in Towson Manor Village this semester. Staff members from Off-Campus Student Services completed a Welcome Back walking tour in the community the first week of school and distributed welcome back bags (bags included University information, promotional items, tips on how to live respectfully in the community, trash schedule, etc.). On September 9, 2009, Towson University held a Welcome Back Meet n' Greet with the residents and students living in Towson Manor Village at the First Lutheran Church. This was an opportunity for neighbors to meet the student ambassador, Liam Davis, and staff members from Off-Campus Student Services. The CA is in the process of developing a community building event that would involve the students and neighbors working together to improve the neighborhood. - **College of Liberal Arts - Phase 2: Underway** – With the first 100,000 square feet complete and opening Fall 2009, the second phase of the 250,000 square-foot project is now underway. CLA is TU's first new academic building in 20 years. **An open house, with self-guided tours is open to the public on Friday, September 25, 2009 between 3-5 p.m.**
